Mr. Pratt then moved to amend said bill by inserting after the word 'contract,' in the 11th section, 27th line there-

of, the following,

'Provided, however, that the said commissioners shall not be authorised to sell said bonds or certificates for less than twenty per centum over and above the par of said bonds and certificates,'

Resolved in the affirmative.

On motion of Mr. Pratt, the year and nays were ordered. On motion of Mr. Merrick, the house was called and the Door-keeper sent for the absent members, who after a short time had elapsed, returned and reported, that he had notified the absent members that their attendance in the house was required.
