Also, the bill, entitled, an act to give effect within the State of Maryland, to the will of the late George Chapman of the State of Virginia; severally endersed will pass, ordered to be engrossed,

And, delivered a bill, originated in and passed by the senate, entitled, a supplement to an act, entitled, an act to incorporate the Real Estate Rank of Frederick county,

Which was read and referred to the committee on ways

and means.

Also, a bill, entitled, a further supplement to an act, entitled, an act to incorporate the Eastern Shore Rail Road Company,

Which was read.

Mr. Teackle moved that said bill be read a second time by special order,

Resolved in the affirmative.

The said bill was then read the second time by special

order, passed and returned to the senate.

On motion of Mr. Brown the house resumed the consideration of the unfinished business of yesterday, being the report of the joint committee on the subject of Internal Improvement.

And the substitute offered for said report, by the minority of said committee, being a bill, entitled, an act for the

promotion of internal improvement.

On motion of Mr. Merrick, said bill was amended, by striking out in the 11th section 14th line, the words "Treasurer of the Western Shore," and inserting in lieu thereof the words, "commissioner of loans of this State under the seal of the State."

Sec. 11. And be it enacted, that so soon as the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company and the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road Company, shall have respectively communicated to the Governor of Maryland, their assent to the terms of this act, in the manner hereinbefore provided; the Commissioner of Loans shall be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to advertise in the cities of Baltimore, Philadelphia, New York and Boston, for at least three successive weeks in two newspapers published daily in said cities, respectively, for proposals to purchase stock or bonds of this State, to be redecinable at any time after the 1st day
