So the amendment was rejected.

On motion of Mr. Merrick, said bill was further amended, by adding at the end of the 12th section thereof, the following,

And the amount so to be invested as a sinking fund from time to time as the several instalments on said foan shall be paid into the Treasury, shall not be less in the whole, and for the whole loan, than five hundred thousand dollars, to be made up of balance of premium not required for the payment of three years interest as aforesaid, the dividends that may arise on the State's stock, in all or either of said companies during the said three years, and the bonus to be paid by the several banks incorporated within this State, since the first day of January, 1836, or so much thereof as may be necessary for this purpose.'

On motion of Mr. McLean, the house reconsidered the 11th section of said bill for the purpose of amendment.
