

On motion of Mr. McLear, said section was amended, by inserting after the word 'who,' in the eighth line, the following,

'Or a majority, or in case of resignation or death in Europe, the remainder of whom.'

On motion of Mr. Merrick, said bill was amended, by inserting as the 12th section thereof, the following,

Sec. 12. And be it enacted, that the proper accounting department of the State of Maryland, is hereby authorised and directed to receive such evidences of ownership, and be governed by such rules respecting the transfer of stock and obligations of the State, as are received and adopted under the authority of the United States for transferring funded debt of the said United States.

On motion of Mr. Ely, said bill was further amended, by inserting after the word 'road,' in the 14th section, seventh line, the following, 'as have been assigned or used, or shall hereafter be.'

Mr. Pratt moved further to amend said bill, by inserting after the word 'transportation,' in the 14th section, seventh line, the following,

'Upon the main stem of said road and the several branches thereof, and that it shall be the duty of said Company to establish at such convenient and suitable places on said main stem and branches, depots for the reception of property for transportation as the Governor and Council shall from time to time direct, due regard being had to the interest of all parties.'

Resolved in the affirmative.
