So the amendment was adopted.

Mr. Brohawn moved further to amend said bill by adding at the end of the 14th section, the following,

‘And be it further enacted, that the sum of two thousand dollars is hereby subscribed on the part of the State to the Black Water and Parson’s Creek Canal Company, in Dorchester county, subject to the same conditions as are imposed upon a similar subscription on the part of the State to the Eastern Shore Rail Road Company.

And be it further enacted, that the sum of four thousand dollars is hereby subscribed on the part of the State to the Transquakin Company, for the purpose of cutting a Canal from some point near Transquakin bridge to the great Choptank river, at or near Hurst’s creek, in Dorchester county, subject to the same conditions as are imposed upon a similar subscription on the part of the State to the Eastern Shore Rail Road Company.’
