Messrs. Duckett and Nowland, of the joint committee upon the part of this house, to wait on his Excellency the Governor, and to invite his attendance in the senate chamber this evening, for the purpose of signing such of the engrossed bills passed at the present session, as have not been signed, reported that the said committee had discharged the duty assigned them, and that the Governor gave for answer, that he would accordingly attend in the senate chamber, at the time appointed, for the purpose above mentioned.

The clerk of the senate returned the bill, entitled, an act supplemental to an act, entitled, an act to establish Magistrates Courts in the several counties in this State, and to prescribe their jurisdiction, passed at Dec. session 1835, endorsed 'reconsidered and first amendment receded from, and the bill ordered to be engrossed,

Also, the bill entitled, an act for the payment of the Journal of accounts, endorsed, 'will pass,' ordered to be engrossed,

Also, the resolution in favour of William B. A. H. Tyler,

Also, the resolution relative to the repairs of the Government house, severally endorsed, 'assented to,' and ordered to be engrossed,

Also, the resolution directing the Armourer to deliver each member of the Senate and House of Delegates, who may apply for a rifle, endorsed, 'will not pass,'

And, delivered the following message;

By the Senate,

June 4th, 1836.

Gentlemen of the House of Delegates,

We have received the message of your honorable body, proposing to adjourn the session this evening at 8 o'clock, and concur with you in the agreement to adjourn sine die, so soon as the ceremony of signing the engrossed bills shall have been performed.
