

ing the Adjutant General to recall all of Hall's patent rifles that have been distributed, endorsed 'assented to,' ordered to be engrossed,

Also, the resolution directing the Armorer to deliver each member of the Senate and House of Delegates, who may apply for a rifle, endorsed 'reconsidered and dissented from,'

And, delivered the engrossed bills of the senate from No. 362 to No. 392, inclusive,

Which were severally read, assented to, and returned to the senate.

Mr. Frantz submitted the following resolution,

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, that if upon enquiry it shall appear to the Armorer that the 95 stand of Hall's patent rifles furnished to this State by the Federal Government, were designed for distribution among the members of the Legislature, the Armorer shall thereupon forward one of said guns to each member of the present General Assembly of this State,

Which was read the first and second time by special order, and assented to.

Mr. Brown asked for the yeas and nays, which call was not sustained by the house.

The said resolution was then sent to the senate.

The Clerk of the Senate returned said resolution, endorsed 'assented to with the proposed amendments,' which amendments were severally read the first and second time by special order.

Mr. Boyd moved that said amendment be rejected, Resolved in the affirmative.

Mr. Brown, chairman of the committee on engrossed bills, delivered the following report,
