The House met. All present as on Yesterday except Mr. Ford. Mr. Hall appeared in the House. The proceedings of Yesterday were read.

The Memorial of Alexander Lawson Smith was read the first Time and ordered to lie on the Table.

A petition of Cornelius Durant, with several Papers relating thereto, was proposed and read, and referred to Committee N. 3.

On Motion, The Question was put on the following to wit, Resolved, That it is the Opinion of this House, that the Bill to be brought in for the Relief of certain Nonjurors, on the Terms therein mentioned, extend so far as to relieve all Nonjurors within this State, on their taking the Oath or making the Affirmation, prescribed by the Act for the better Security of the Government, by a Day in the Bill to be limited, from all Penalties and Disabilities in said Act, except that they shall not hold or enjoy any Places of Trust or Profit, nor shall they sit in the public Councils of this State, nor shall they vote or be voted for at any Election whatsoever. Carried in the Negative.

On Motion, the Question was put, That the Bill to be brought in for the Relief of certain Nonjurors, on the Terms therein mentioned, be postponed till next Session of Assembly? Carried in the Negative
