as to substitute artificial for real conviction and thereby give coloring to a code
of polity which may hereafter be turned to the destruction of that manly freedom
for which we are now contending. Who can be safe if we resort to subtle and circu-
-mud construction as the lycopung of common life?

Our Petitioners therefore humbly pray that the proceedings of the Committee
may be re-considered. If they have erred let censure & deprecate punishment;
it is however hoped that rectitude of intention will shield them from imputed guilt.

goods for ready money. And at the same time declaring, that he would not sell his
goods for Cash but for Tobacco only.

Resolved that Mr Archibald Campbell be required immediately to attend
the Committee, to answer unto the matter wherewith charges

Whereupon Mr Archibald Campbell, after hearing a full & plain reading
of the said complaint, and in the presence of the said Archibald examined relative to the complaint
aforesaid made. Who proved the fact as alleged to the general satisfaction of the
Committee. Who thereupon proceeded, after having first heard what Mr Campbell
had to offer in his defense, to take into their consideration the indecency of such a
procedure, which upon being fully debated, duly weighed & maturely considered
was almost unanimously judged to be a manifest violation of the sixth Article
of the Provincial Convention held at Annapolis, who by adjournment on the eighth day
of December seventeen hundred and seventy four.

And therefore Resolved for ourselves & constituents, that no gentleman in the Land,
from this time forward ought to bring or prosecute any suit for ready money to the
Office of Dr Blaifford Equine Company at Leonard Town of which the said Factor Mr.
Archibald Campbell has the management.

Resolved also that the proceedings against the said Archibald Campbell be published
in the Maryland Gazette to the intent, that all persons concerned may have due
notice thereof.

At the same time upon complaint made by Capt George Loker against Mr William Ellsworth
Factor for Mr James Buchanan Company at their Store at St. Georges concerning forwarding in a
similar manner, which the said William Ellsworth has present admits to be true.

Resolved that the said Ellsworth has violated the agreed Recd, and that he also
be published in the Maryland Gazette to the intent as aforesaid.
