

Ordered, That Messrs Daniel and John M<sup>r</sup> Henry deliver to Major Gist 4062<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> yards of Broadbrims purchased of them by the Council of the City.

Ordered, That Messrs Robert and Samuel Purrance deliver to Major Gist all the Canvas now in their Possession purchased of Abner Page for Tent by the late Convention, and that he procure the same to be immediately made up.

Adjourned till next Day 10 o'clock.

Friday 1<sup>st</sup> March 1740

Council Met. Present as Yesterday.

Ordered, That Major Gist furnish Captain Fulford with a quantity of Cloth sufficient to clothe his Company.

M<sup>r</sup> Nicholas Quater Moore was appointed third Lieutenant of Capt. Fulford's Company of Matrices Commission issued to him accordingly.

Ordered, That Messrs Samuel Purrance Junr, William Smith and David Stewart pay to Messrs William Love and Daniel Bowley twelve hundred and two pounds eighteen Shillings and nine pence being the balance of their account with the Province in consequence of an Adventure by the Schooner Seaflower.

Permit was granted to Messrs Samuel Purrance Junr, William Smith and David Stewart and others concerned in the Adventure of the Schooner Seaflower, - to sell the produce of the Province to the amount of four hundred and eight pounds and five pence agreeable to a Resolution of Council.

Doctor George Budd was appointed Surgeon of the Ship of the Line, and Doctor Nathan Boney Junr. Mate.

Adjourned till next Day 10 o'clock.

Saturday 2<sup>d</sup> March 1740.

Council Met. Present as Yesterday.

Commission issued to Sir John Williams appointed third Lieutenant of Captain Thomas Fulford's Independent Company.

Resolved, That Major Gist be empowered to contract for 4000 Coats of Cloth and as many hats as may be necessary for the Battalion not exceeding 4000.

M<sup>r</sup> Hugh Young agreed with the Council to load the Schooner Peggy with Country produce, and in return to import Salt agreeable to a Resolution of Council. Doctor Charles Jeremiah Wicenthal was appointed Surgeon of the Battalion. Commission issued to Genl. Welch appointed Private of Captain John Cox's Company of Militia in Baltimore County in the room of David M<sup>r</sup> Clellan who removed out of the Province.

Ordered, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to M<sup>r</sup> David Grant five pounds fifteen Shillings for the use of his room and Dockkeeper.

Ordered, That the said Treasurer pay to M<sup>r</sup> William Love one thousand pounds Currency on account of the Ship of the Line.
