Lucas Sixty nine pounds fifteen Shillings, being the balance of his general
account to the 3rd instant.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Birch May-
bury, Cornelius Gersten and Mr. Mallett nine pounds each for finding
the depth of the River between Greenbury Point and Hornpoint.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Mr. John Gibson three Pounds
five Shillings for Boat hire as per account.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Capt. John Haskins Stone
forty eight pounds ten Shillings, being the balance of his general account
to the 5th instant.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay Major Thomas Price £39.3
for Cloathing of the Troop.
