

Ordered, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain George Stricker fifty one pounds sixteen Shillings for 102 Pair of Shoes and the Wagg-
age of them to Annapolis.

Resolved, That there be a Convention of the Delegates of this Province held
at the City of Annapolis on Tuesday the 7th of May next.

Copies of Letter N^o. 127. were sent to the Delegates in Convention for each
County and District within the Province respectively, and a Copy of 20128.
to the Deputies of this Province in Congress.

Ordered, That the Company of Stores deliver to Captain John Allen Thomas
13 Musquets, 4 Rifles, 6 Musquet Bullet Moulds, 4 Rifle ditto, and 5¹² Bolls of
Osnaaburgs.

Ordered, That the Company of Stores deliver to Captain John Allen Thomas
for Captain Perin Beall's independent Company, 29 Musquets, 4 Rifles, powder Horns
Pouches and Bullet Moulds, 6 Musquet Bullet Moulds, 300 Gun flints, 100 Gunslings
62 Cartouch boxes and Belts, 104 Hats and 5 Bolls of Osnaaburgs.

Ordered, That Captain John Allen Thomas be requested to purchase all
the Buck shot he can procure in Saint Mary's County.

Ordered, That Col. Joshua Beall be requested to send 4 Barrels and 20 Keggs
of Musquet Gunpowder out of the gunpowder now in his possession to the Committee
of Observation for Charles County; and 35 Musquets from John Youst, in a Covered
Waggon under a Guard of a Commissioned officer and two privates of Militia;
the 35 Musquets for Captain Perin Beall's Company.

Ordered, That the Committee of Observation for Charles County be
requested to convey 1 Barrel and 10 Keggs of the gunpowder to be sent them by
Col Joshua Beall, to the Committee of Observation for St. Mary's County; and
one Barrel and 10 Keggs of the same powder to the Committee of Calvert County;
also 600^{lb}. Lead to the Committee of St. Mary's County; and 600^{lb}. Lead to the
Committee of Calvert County, for the use of the said Counties.

Adjourned till next day 10 o'clock

Council met Present as Yesterday.

Col. John Beazley returns to the Council £500 in Bills of Credit of this
Province which were sent him by Capt Robert Craig, on the 14th day of February
last, for the purpose of purchasing Gunpowder.

Ordered, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain John Allen
Thomas twenty eight pounds fourteen Shillings and five pence being the Balance of his
general account to the 31st of April.

Ordered, That the said Treasurer pay to Capt. Thomas three hundred and ninety
four Pounds one Shilling and eight pence on account of his Company.

Ordered, That Mr. Athanasius Ford of St. Mary's County pay to Capt. John
Allen Thomas twenty seven pounds seven Shillings and six pence for so much
Money paid him over and above the just amount of his account on the 12th of April.

Ordered, That the Company of Stores deliver to Capt. Thomas 40 Barrels
