Ordered, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to M^r Frederick Green six pounds three Shillings and four pence for the purposes mentioned in the above Order.

Ordered, That the said Treasurer pay to M^r Frederick Green seventy four Pounds in part payment of his Account against the Province for printing.
