Shillings for 3 months pay as Surgeon's Mate.

Ordered, That Treasurer a/c pay to Capt. Edward Neasey seven hundred
Pounds on acct. of his Company.

Ordered, That Treasurer a/c pay to Richard Thompson for use of John Cost
one hundred and fifty pounds to enable him to carry on his Gun Manufactory.

Ordered, That Treasurer of Eastern Shore pay to James Mills four pounds, twelve
Shillings and one penny Currency for the Carriage of Powder from Chester Town to the
Lower Counties on Eastern Shore.

Richard Thompson was appointed Supervisor of the Salt Peter Works in
the Lower District of Frederick County in the room of Mr. Richardson who had
resigned.

It was Thereupon, Ordered, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay
to said Thompson one hundred pounds allotted by the late Convention for that
purpose.

A Resolve of Congress was communicated to this Board, relative to the
apprehension of a certain Kirkland, who lately made his escape from the jail
of Phil^a wherein he was confined by order of Congress. And thereupon ordered
that an Advertisement be immediately inserted in Maryland News-papers for
apprehension of said Ross, as also Copy of said Resolution together with the
Advertisement be forthwith transmitted to the Committee of Safety of
Virginia by Express.
