Ordered, That Commissary of Stores at Baltimore Town deliver to Capt<sup>t</sup> Campbell (on Loan) 300<sup>wt</sup> of Sheet Lead.

Ordered, That Treasurer of Western Shore pay to Hugh Young twelve hundred pounds Currency for sum of Insurance of Brig Nancy Capt<sup>t</sup> Wise.

Ordered, That Treasurer of Western Shore pay to Hugh Young eighty three pounds fifteen Shillings and one penny Currency for Balance of Schooner thirty two's Cargo.

Ordered, That said Treasurer pay to Capt<sup>t</sup> Fulford, one hundred and one pounds, nine Shillings for Gun Carriages.

Ordered, That Commissary of Stores at Baltimore Town deliver to Mess<sup>rs</sup> Dan<sup>l</sup> and Sam<sup>l</sup> Hughes whatever Quantity of Powder that may be necessary for the Proof of Cannon to be supplied this Province according to his Contract.

Commissions issued to Stephen Hylands app<sup>t</sup> Capt<sup>t</sup> W<sup>m</sup> Neazy 1<sup>st</sup> W<sup>m</sup> Mauldin 2<sup>nd</sup> Lieut. and Nathan Arrants Ensign of a company of Militia in Cecil County.
