Ordered. That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Col. Zedekiah Magawick ten pounds more and ten pence for Expenses incurred in guarding the Prisoners sent from North Carolina, from George Town to Perwich Town.

Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to Col. Zedekiah Magawick fifteen pounds Common Money for three months pay of the Captain to his Battalion of Militia to the 6th Instant.

Ordered. That the following notice be given in the Maryland Gazette, to wit: All persons who are willing to undertake the Militia and Campaign on Salt Works agreeable to a Resolve of last Convention are required to attend the Council of Safety and give in their Proposals which will be duly attended to.

Met according to adjournment. Present the same Members as on yesterday.

Ordered. That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Col. William Prater ten pounds Common Money for transporting Militia from Annapolis to Baltimore Town, and from thence to the Western Shore.

Mr. John Muir, appointed accountant to the Board of Accounts appeared before the Council and qualified himself as such by taking the oath directed by the Convention to be taken by the Clerk to the Council of Safety, except instead of the words "as Clerk to the Council of Safety" inserting "as accountant to the Board of Accounts".
