Ordered, That the said Treasurer pay to Major Gist three hundred and eighteen Pounds six Shillings and five pence, the amount of his account.

Ordered, That the said Treasurer pay to William Niven fifteen Pounds two Shillings and seven pence, the amount of his account.

Adjourned to 17 June 1770.

Met according to adjournment. Present the same Members as on Saturday.

Ordered That the Commissary of Stores, deliver to Lieutenant John Waters, for Capt. John Gunbys Company, twenty five Musquets and fifteen Rifles with Powder Horns and Pouches.

Ordered, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Capt. John Day Scott ninety four Pounds four Shillings and five pence on account of his Company.

Commissions issued to Vachel Gaither appointed Capt., Abalom Anderson 1st Lieut. Stephen Basford 2^d Lieutenant, and Thomas Fowler Basford Ensign of a Company of militia belonging to the seven Battalion in Ann Arundel County.

Copy of Letter # 25. was sent to Capt. Isaac Vanbitters.

Ordered, That the Treasurer of the Eastern Shore pay to Captain James Hindman one hundred and forty nine pounds seven Shillings Currency for subsisting his Company to 30th of May.

Ordered, That the Commissary of Stores deliver to William Hayward Esq. for Capt. James Hindmans Company, fifteen Rifles with Powder Horns and Pouches, eleven Musquets, and thread sufficient to make one hundred Suits of Cloths.

Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to said Nathaniel Curing thirty pence.
