Ordered, That the said Treasurer pay to Mr. William Luxe one hundred Pounds Currency for the Freight of Powder from St. Eustatia.

Copy of Letter n^o 27 was sent to the Committee of Observation for Worcester County.

Ordered. That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Gordon of Baltimore Town one hundred and twenty four Pounds one Shilling Common Money, being the Balance of his account for Cartouch Boxes Bayonet Belts and Gunflings.

Ordered. That the said Treasurer pay to Erasmus Uhler of Baltimore Town fifty nine pounds ten Shillings, the Balance of his account for Cartouch Boxes, Bayonet Belts and Gunflings.

Ordered. That the said Treasurer pay to Col. George Plata eight Pounds four Shillings and six Pence for Expenses incurred in erecting Beacons on the River Patowmack.
