Ordered that the Commission of Stores deliver to Capt. John (Dean) 3 Canteen Boxes, 60 Gunslings, 14 Iron Pots or Kettles, 1 Box of Ammunition and one Line of Cartridge Paper.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Clerk twenty pounds for expenses.

Adjourned till next Day 10 O'clock.

Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> July 1776.

Council Met. Present the same Members as on Yesterday.

Copy of Letter #99 was sent to Major Thomas Price, copy of #100 to Thomas Jones Esq. Chairman of the Committee of Observation for Northumberland County, Virginia, and copy of #101 to Capt. Thomas Conway.

Ordered that the Commanding Officer at the City of Annapolis, be requested to take into his Custody the Goods of William Veldell and a servant man at Whitehall, a cooper by trade, and then safely bring before the Council.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Robert Elliot thirty Shillings for painting Gunfannings.

Adjourned till 3 O'clock & met accordingly.

Copy of Letter #102 to Mr. Joshua Griffin and copy of #103 to Mr. Alexander McFadon.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Capt. Peter Mantry fifty Pounds to be accounted for.

That said Treasurer pay to John Gordon and Matthew Patten four hundred Pounds on account of their Contract.

The Council Contracted with John Gordon and Matthew Patten for the making 2600 Hapsacks and Haversacks on the Terms specified in an agreement of this Day.

Ordered that the Commanding officer of the Schooner Resolution immediately proceed to Indian Landing with the powder in her, and there land the same.

That Captain James Lott be requested to receive at Indian Landing from the Commanding officer of the Schooner Resolution 50 Barrels and nine half barrels of Gunpowder, and procure Carts at the public expense to convey the same, to the Magazine near his House.

Adjourned till next day 10 O'clock.

Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> August 1776.

Council Met. Present the same Members as on Yesterday.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Joseph Nicholson of the Council fifteen Pounds fifteen Shillings for 24 Days attendance as a Member.
