

Nineteen Shillings and two pence for 93¹/₃ Dozen forming iron and bridle.
That the said Treasurer pay to William Jacob fourteen pounds seven shillings and three pence for tent making.

Adjourned till Monday Morning 10 O'clock.

Monday 12th August 1776.

Council met. Present the same Members as on Saturday.

Ordered. That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Parker three pounds five shillings for a musquet.

That the said Treasurer pay to John (David) thirteen pounds ten shillings for nine days hire of his Schooner to transport Captain John Allen Thomas's Company from St. Mary's County to Annapolis.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt. John Dean thirty pounds to provide Subsistence for his Company the same to be charged to the Contractors.

Ordered, that the Company of Stores deliver to Col. Thomas Ewing for Capt. Young's Company 15 Camp Stettles, 86 Knapsacks and Haversacks and 86 wooden Bottles.

Copy of Letter N^o 130. was sent to Col. Thomas Ewing, and Copy of N^o 131 to Mr. Gerard Hopkins of Baltimore Town.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Edward Timmons three pounds twelve shillings and five pence for a musquet.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt. Belair Posey seventy five pounds, six shillings and six pence for arms and Blankets, and one hundred and twenty five pounds on account of his Company.

Adjourned till next Day 10 O'clock.

Tuesday 13 August 1776.

Council met. Present the same Members as on Yesterday.

Copy of Letter N^o 132 was sent to Col. Mr. Hyde.

Ordered that the Committee of Observation for Stafford County deliver to Col. Mr. Hyde all the musquets and Blankets in their possession, belonging to the Publick.

Ordered that Western Shore Treasurer pay to Dan. & Sam. Hughes two thousand pounds, on acct of his contract, for a Cannon Foundry.

Commission issued to Mr. Perry appointed Quarter Master to the 4th Battalion of Militia, in the room of Nick. Thomas, who resigned.

Ordered that Eastern Shore Treasurer pay to Sam. Edmundson seventy pounds Currency.

Ordered that Western Shore Treasurer pay to Isaac Simmons five pounds for two guns.

Captain Campbell's Company was commissioned.

Ordered. That Western Shore Treasurer pay to Henry Badgely four pounds, ten shillings for a musquet & Bayonet.

Ordered that Western Shore Treasurer pay to Capt. W^m Waters one hundred and seventy five for a boat.
