Ordered that Capt John Gordon immediately march his Company to the City of Alexandria & there abide for the further Orders of the Committee of Safety

Ordered that Capt John Brooke immediately march his Company to Green Point, and there take his Station till further Orders from the Council of Safety. And the Committee of Observation are requested to report on circumstances from the Militia to be used by said Company: whilst at that Station.

Ordered that Western Shore Treasurer pay to Capt Robert Jones for use of the Committee of Peace George County, three hundred pounds as per account sent in.

Saturday 1st of August 1775

Council met Present as on Yesterday.

Ordered, That Western Shore Treasurer pay to Capt John Williams seventy two Pounds, twelve Shillings & eleven Pence, for expenses of his Company.

Ordered that said Treasurer pay to James Taylor Nine Pounds for Camp wheels for Cannon.

Ordered that said Treasurer pay to Col. M^{rs} Richard for two hundred fifty nine Pounds fifteen Shillings and eight Pence, for pay of 11th Battalion of militia on duty.

Ordered that said Treasurer pay to Patrick Herman forty two Pounds, fifteen Shillings for Tent poles.

Ordered that Western Shore Treasurer pay to Lieut James Williamson for use of Capt Thomas Smyth, one hundred and thirty five pounds, for pay and subsists of his Company.

Ordered that said Treasurer pay to Isaac Harris ninety five pounds eleven Shillings for his services as Announced.

Ordered, That Capt Thomas Ringgold pay to Lieut James Williamson for the use of Capt Thomas Smyth thirty pounds Continental Currency to be paid the expenses of his March to the Flying Camp.

Ordered, That Western Shore Treasurer pay to Col. Hyde for the use of Thomas Jones
