Ordered that Western Shore Treasurer pay to Rich^d. Weems twelve shillings for & on acct of his Company.

Ordered that Commission of Stores at Annapolis deliver to John Davidson one Barrel of Musquet Gun Powder, in exchange for one Barrel of Cannon Shot.

Commissions issued to Solomon Long appointed First Lieutenant, Ely Dorsey 2 Lieut^s & Rich^d. Grace 3^d Lieut^s of an Independent Company.

Ordered that Western Shore Treasurer pay to Eliz^a. Sharpe two pounds, fifteen shillings & six pence for nursing the sick at Hospital.

Ordered that said Treasurer pay to Philip Waterland fifteen shillings for attending sick at Hospital.

Ordered that Paymaster pay to Captain Watkins one Months pay ending 3rd Day of Sept^r inst.

Ordered that Western Shore Treasurer pay to Edw^d. Hall one hundred and thirteen pounds, fifteen shillings & ten pence, for his Company of Militia on Duty.

Ordered that said Treasurer pay to Lieut. Henry Dennis for use of Philip Fieldman four hundred and seventy five pounds, seven shillings and ten pence, for and on account of his Company.

Ordered that Eastern Shore Treasurer pay to Col^l. Benson Stanton, two hundred and seven pounds, two shillings and six pence, for Militia duty.
