Commissions issued to Joseph Hall appointed Surgeon, J^r Johnson & Rich^d. Donning Surgeon Assistants to Col^o Griffiths Battalion of Flying Camp.

Adjourned till Monday 10 O'clock.

Monday. September 9th 1776.

Council Met. Present as on yesterday.

Ordered that Western Shore Treasurer pay to Lieut Wm Beall for the use of Capt. Robert Bowie six pounds for pay for part of his Company.

Ordered that said Treasurer pay to Capt. Uriah Forrest three hundred and thirty four Pounds, fifteen shillings and nine Pence for pay and Subsist^s of his Company.

Ordered that said Treasurer pay to said Forrest for use of Belwood & Parson five Pounds, five shillings for Boatage.

Ordered that said Treasurer pay to Pollard Edmondson for use of David M^r. Intosh, twenty four pounds, for four Months Adjutancy.

Ordered that said Treasurer pay to Joshua Ingers three pounds for boatage.

Ordered that said Treasurer pay to Robert Cummings one thousand pounds on acct. of Subsist^s of Troops.

Ordered that said Treasurer pay to Hileary Milton thirty shillings for Subsist^s of part of Flying Camp.
