

Ordered that said Treasurer pay to Henry Sewell eight pounds, six shillings and eleven pence for Subsidy for Flying Camp.

Ordered That the Quartermaster of the Eastern Shore advance and pay to the guard of the Eastern Shore Magazine, or any person Authorized to receive the same, one shilling & man & day for Subsidy and such pay as due to the Militia when in actual service, the guard consisting of a Sergeant and eight men at the expiration of each month.

Ordered That Western Shore Treasurer pay to John Smith twenty four pounds fourteen shillings for Quarters.

Ordered that said Treasurer pay to John Carleton for the use of the said Prachemen five hundred pounds on acct of Quarters.

Copy of Letter N^o 172 was sent to General Sullivan.

N^o 173 to Col. George Thompson.

N^o 174 to the Committee of Privation in Baltimore County.

Ordered that Western Shore Treasurer pay to Capt. John Mackie eight one pounds six shillings & four pence for Militia on duty.

Adjourned till next day 11 o'clock.

Wednesday September 18th 1775.

Council met. Present the same members as on yesterday.

Ordered That Western Shore Treasurer pay to Capt. John Mackie for their Quarters and twenty one pounds fourteen shillings and four pence for and on acct of Quarters.

Capt. John Mackie's company commended.

Ordered That Western Shore Treasurer pay to James Foster six one pounds, fourteen shillings & three pence for acct of acct.

Ordered that said Treasurer pay to W^m Hughes four pounds fourteen shillings for Subsidy of part of Flying Camp.

Ordered that said Treasurer pay to Cornelius Peniston twenty four pounds four shillings & three pence for acct of acct.

Copy of Letter N^o 175 was sent to Col. Smallwood & Major General Bull.

Ordered That Col. W^m Smallwood be requested to procure a Stamp, to be made on which the word Provincia shall be engraved, and that he therewith Cause all the Arms belonging to this State in the Hands of the regular Troops including the Independent Companies, to be stamped. And Benjamin General Bull, or the Commanding Officer of the Militia of the Flying Camp is requested to Cause all the guns in the hands of the said Independent Troops, to be stamped in the same manner.

Ordered that Western Shore Treasurer pay to Col. John Bull five hundred pounds for and on account of the Militia Company to be raised in the Department of Baltimore County.

Ordered that said Treasurer pay to Wm Fisher six hundred pounds for and on acct of the Company to be raised in the South Side of Baltimore County.
