month from this date at twelve shillings and six pence.

They also Contracted with George Gordon for the Making two thousand
Cartouch Boxes, Bayonet Belts, & Gunslings at twelve shillings and six pence.

Ordered that Western Shore Treasurer pay to George Gordon three
hundred pounds on acct of above Contract.

Ordered that Western Shore Treasurer pay to Colonel John Dorsey & M^{rs}.
