Council Met. Present as on Yesterday.

Ordered that Western Shore Treasurers pay to W^m Juck, eighteen pounds ten shillings for 37 days attendance, as doorkeeper to the Council.

Ordered that said Treasurers pay to Catharine Nixon thirty shillings for attending Hospitals.

Ordered that said Treasurers pay to Selby & Howards thirty four shillings and six pence for audit of account.

Ordered that said Treasurers pay to Joseph Selby two hundred and fifty Pounds in acct of his Contract for Cartouch boxes.

Ordered that Mr. John Post of George Town deliver to Lieut. Frederick Skinner all the Musquets he has ready made for the public service.

Ordered that W. Shore Treasurers pay to Lieut. Colmore Williams five pounds, two shillings and ten pence, for Board of part of Capt. Durren's Company.

Council Met. Present as on yesterday. Mr. Thomas attended.

Warrant granted to Mr. Ridgeway of Queen Anne's County to raise a Company, agreeable to the resolves of last Convention.

Ordered that W. Shore Treasurers pay to Lieut. Mark Denton, for the use of Captain Ridgeway four hundred and twenty nine pounds, for Bounty and one months pay.

Ordered that said Treasurers pay to Bro^t J. Hall of Colonel Griffiths Battalion of Flying Camp twenty Pounds, for advance.

Copy of Letter N^o 189 was sent to Capt. James Nicholson.

Ordered that Western Shore Treasurers pay to John Bullen two hundred Pounds for the purchase of two horses, a Cart, a light Wagon & proper Gear.

Copy of Letter N^o 190 was sent to the Committee of Baltimore County.

Passport was granted to Josh. Dowson, Arch^d. Chrisolme, and request Accomies. Rhaaphahannah, Cambridge, Fort Mifflin and James River.

Ordered that Western Shore Treasurers pay to Capt. Daniel Claydon the fifty four Pounds ten shillings and six pence, for travelling expenses of his Company.
