Council met Present as on Yesterday.

Commission issued to Francis Hollands appointed Captain of a company in Bedford County.

Ordered that Western Treasurers pay to John Waller eight pounds eleven shillings & six pence for arrears of acct.

Ordered that Western Shore Treasurers pay to John Waller forty pounds for charges for Hospital.

John Williams & Thomas Chambers of Capt. Longs Independent Company permitted to go to Winchester County for the recovery of their debts.

Ordered that Col. Wallace Esq. Paymaster advance one month's pay to John Williams & Thomas Chambers of Capt. Longs Company ending the 5th instant.

Ordered that Western Shore Treasurers pay to Beniah Mayberry seven pounds and six pence for Arrears of acct.

Ordered that Said Treasurers pay to Egidius Jorgens, twenty pounds to be accounted for.

The Council of Safety appointed Egidius Jorgens to be Captain of a guard for a detachment in Frederick County, being obliged to have twelve men, not more.
