Friday November 8th 1776.

Council Met. Present as on Yesterday.

The Council of Safety Contracted with Jacob Madeira for two hundred pair of shoes, and Ordered that Western Shore Treasurer pay to Jacob Madeira sixty Pounds, for the above Contract.

Ordered that Western Shore Treasurer pay to Woodman Gibson thirty shillings for a Gun.

Ordered that Western Shore Treasurer pay to Doct. Richard Lott, seventeen pounds, twelve shillings and six pence.

Ordered that said Treasurer pay Robert Cummings two thousand pounds.

Ordered that said Treasurer pay to Thomas Wilson ten pounds, for his time being remitted, by order of the Convention.

Ordered that said Treasurer pay to John Bullen two hundred and thirty Pounds.

Ordered that said Treasurer pay to Col^o. John Muddock, one hundred and two pounds, seventeen shillings, and eight pence.

Ordered that those persons who keep Patuxes and Susquehanna Rivers be desired from time to time, by night or day, to put the Postmaster General's Orders over those Rivers, during the Continuance of the War.

Mr. Tho^s. Smyth agreed with the Council of Safety to purchase one hundred Barrels of Beef, on acc^t. at the Commission of five percent.

Council of Safety agree with Colonel Hore for all the salt imported in the Brigantine Friendship at 15/- per Bushel.

Saturday November 9th 1776.

Council Met. Present as on Yesterday.

Commissions issued to William Mackie appointed 1st Lieut. Joseph Hill 2^d Lieut. and John Thomas Ensign of Capt. Mackalls Company of Militia in Frederick County.

Ordered that Western Shore Treasurer pay to Mr. Hony one hundred eighty three pounds, eleven shillings and one Penny.
