Ordered, That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Capt. Thomas Conway fifty five Bushels of Salt.

Commissions issued to Thomas M<sup>o</sup> Williams appointed Captain of Marines on Board the Sloop Molly. Thomas Conway, Commanded.

Copy of Letter N<sup>o</sup> 58 was sent to Capt. Ignatius Taylor, and Copy of N<sup>o</sup> 59 to Brigadier General, Johnson, Buchanan, Chamberlain, and Col. Charles Burnsey respectively.

Ordered that Capt. Patterson be directed to send off with all dispatch, all the vessels he can procure, to the Head of Elk or French Town to bring down Military Stores thereunto, that the said Capt. Patterson man M<sup>o</sup> Williams's Schooner with the other vessels, and supplyed with Provisions for that Purpose, and apply to Col. Henry Hollingsworth there.
