For We received yours of the 10th Instant —
inclosing a List of Officers for Captⁿ Waters's Company,
who you say, have resigned — this may be the Case, but
the Council of Safety think it not regular to issue new
Commissions, until the old ones are transmitted to us, and
therefore have not sent them — We have before us —
also a Petition from the Eden-School Company for a
Change of Officers, their Captain, Andrew Adams they
allege had a Commission made out by the Convention
falsely and fraudulently — this we think, ought
most properly to be referred to the Convention themselves, —
which will meet again in April, and all Parties will
then have an Opportunity of being heard — we cannot
think of displacing Officers appointed by the Convention
without a full Hearing — and no recommendation
