Sir We have received yours of the 21st Instant signi-
fying Mr. Edmondson's refusing to accept of his Com-
mission. The Council do not incline to make any
Changes among the Officers commissioned by the Convention,
but wish to have a Recommendation from you of a proper
Person to fill the Place of Mr. Edmondson. We have agreed
with some of the Officers to allow 20s. for each Pair of
Leather Breeches furnished the Troops and the Remainder
of the Price to be deducted out of the Men's Wages.

The Council apprehend the Captains of the
Independent Companies are to provide Leathering for
themselves.
