Sir,

Your Brother has been so obliging as
to communicate to me from Time to Time such Intelli-
gence, as you have transmitted to him, respecting the
Affairs in Maryland, and about 10. Days
ago I had the Satisfaction to receive your Letter
of the 5th of May. - I sincerely wish you may
not have been too sanguine in your Hopes, that the
Time is not far distant, when Peace and Harmony
will be restored, and Confidence re-established,
