Chairman, and Mr. George Lee Clerk of the Committee
of Observations for Baltimore County, to appear before
us this Day, and to bring with them all the Proceedings
Papers, Letters, Orders, Entries, Instructions &c
relative to the intercepted Letters - we are resolved to
have a full and open Examination of the Affairs, &
shall then cheerfully submit our Conduct to the
Public.

We consider the Authority of the
whole Province trampled upon, and insulted (if not
