would make the best Enquiry you can into the Circum-
stances and Conditions of the Prisoners, and have those
kept, that you may think entitled to any Indul-
gence in some Room or Rooms in French Town, under
a proper Guard - the others in the public Prison
there; until the Try House is got ready, which we
hope will be done soon - the Comventions from
North Carolina have sent us no State of the Prison-
ers' particular Cases, nor any thing more than we
inclose you a Copy of - they are to do it soon -
should any of the Prisoners incline to hand any
State of their Case in writing to us, we should
be obliged to you to forward any such - and we
