we have given the necessary Orders on the Occasion; the  
Expences we shall defray for the present, not doubting, but our  
Province will hereafter be re-imbursed.

We have since received a Letter from  
your Congress with a List somewhat different from  
yours. — we shall transmit Copies to Pennsylvania.

You will be pleased to send us a written Memorial, or  
State of their Case, so far as relates to the Prisoners  
to be confined here, that we may know how to treat  
them properly. — We are &c.
