therefore we have given him no Orders for its Remo-  
val, but will exchange, if you think proper for  
the same quantity, to be delivered us by your  
Delegates at Philadelphia. We are &c.

Gent<sup>rs</sup> This Board have been requested by the  
Convention to countermand your Orders for sailing  
you are therefore not to move from y<sup>r</sup> Station till
