Seaboard County.

Your Capt. Beale has complained that
he hath not sufficient house-rooms for the
half Company stationed at Duck Point, and has
requested some thing may be done; we therefore desire
you would make enquiry into the affairs; and if

there are not houses sufficient, we would have you
cause Barracks to be erected, so that the men
may be lodged without inconvenience to their
Captains and themselves. — We are &c
