Sir, As we are dispatching the Troops from here to Philad, including those for Baltimore, they will amount to 1000 Men; and they are to go by water to the Head of Elk - when they arrive there, perhaps they may be at a Loss for a supply of Provision for their march, which may take them up four Days from thence - we therefore think it necessary that you or Mr. Cummings, or some Person for you, should be there, to be ready to supply them, in case they should be in want. We are &c.
