Sir,

As a considerable time has elapsed, since your erecting your Gun Lock Manufactory, we are in great hopes you have made a number for the use of this Province. The Province is in great distress for arms - few of the Troops raised for the flying camp are supplied with them, if the militia will not have theirs. - there is an absolute necessity therefore, that you immediately send down what locks you have; we expect some locks from N. York, they may come from thence, if you continue them there - we desire also to know how many Locks you make per week; we have Barrels enough here Gun Stocks for the Locks you can make.
