in the Companies of the Battalion we propose to
keep, are not half armed - you must depend on your
former order to the Committee - we have advanced
the sum of £125. 0. 0 each to Capt. Poffy of Home -
you are to account with Capt. Lewis for £200-0-0, which
he says you have already furnished him with; - we expect
to have the pleasure of seeing you in Annapolis before
you go, when you have sent off the three Companies; we
are obliged to transmit our Accts to Congress, and
therefore request you to send your papers to settle your
whole Acct.
