Sir,

By order of Convention you are immediately to March to Philadelphia where you will receive further orders. The service requires the utmost expedition — You will go to the Head of Elk by Water where Provision and Baggage Wagons will be provided for you. — If those who have Sent Guns upon condition your Troops continued in Queen Anne County, insist upon having them returned, you will then supply the deficiency occasioned thereby out of Captain Dames's company, which has a Number of guns purchased by the Committee. —

You are requested to apply to Major Fallin for the guns he has the care of, which were taken in a Tender and you are likewise to apply to the Committee of your County for all the guns they have by them to arm your Company agreeable to a Resolve of Convention which you have herewith inclosed, those two parcels of guns together with what you have otherwise procured, will completely arm your Company, and by the order of Convention you are immediately to March your Company to Philadelphia and there you'll receive further orders
