Sir, We send you enclosed a Resolves of Convention
relative to the Company, which you have a warrant to enlist,
and desire you will immediately make us a return of the men
enrolled, — if your Company is full, or nearly so, you will inform
us of it, and in what forwardness you are for marching; but if
it is not, you will then discharge such, as have enrolled, and
return the Bounty money not expended. —
