some Promise to Mr. Hensley about purchasing Pork in Queen-
Annis, by Board to write to him to know, if he has, or can engage
any; - if he should, and apply to you for Salt, let him have
some, and we will send more to you. - We wish it was in our
Power to relieve the distresses of the people, occasioned by the want
of these necessary Articles. Our Agents at Martinique and St. Louis
advise us that they will do every thing in their Power towards
