Assembly met. Present the same Members as yesterday.

Resolved, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Capt. Nathaniel Smith two hundred pounds current Money for present and advance Money for his Receipts.

Resolved, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Bennett Adams two hundred pounds current Money for present and advance Money for Captain Roger Mearns's military

Resolved, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Capt. Samuel Smith one hundred and twenty pounds for present and advance Money for his Receipts.

Commissions issued to Thomas Dixon Esq: first Major, and to Joseph Garrison Esq: second Major of the South River Battalion of Militia in Amherst County: and to Mr. Pollard Edwards as joint appointed third Lieutenant of the South independent company of regular Troops, in the Room of Mr. William Goff, being discharged.
