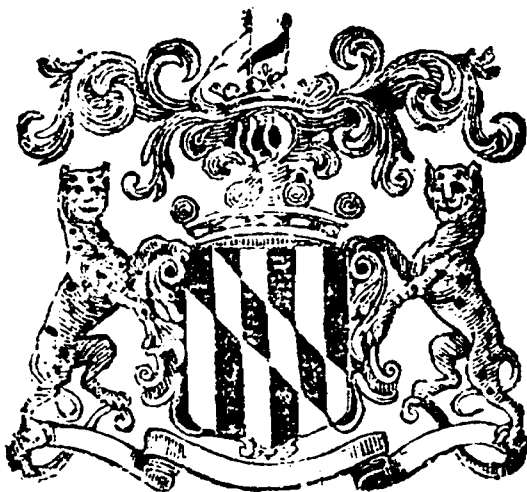

A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS the present General Assembly of this Province, stands prorogued to *Monday* the *first* Day of *February* next; and, whereas there is no Business of Moment which requires their Attendance at that Time, I have thought fit, with the Advice of his Lordship's Council of State, further to prorogue the same, and I do hereby further prorogue the same, to *Monday* the *21st* Day of *May* next. And, to the Intent that all Persons concerned may have due Notice thereof, I DO strictly charge and require the several Sheriffs of this Province, to make this my Proclamation public in their respective Counties, in the usual Manner, as they will answer the Contrary at their Peril.

Given at ANNAPOLIS, this *fourth* Day of *January*
in the *17th* Year of his Lordship's Dominion, *Annoque*
