W E have lately Received from you a Petition and Complaint against the Lord *Baltimore* his Governor and Officers there, who upon pretence of some uncertain Papers and Relations to be sent out of *England*, but no way certified or authenticated, have presumed to recede from their Obedience to the Common-wealth of *England*, to which they were reduced by the Parliaments Commissioners; to the contrary whereof, nothing hath been sent out of *England*, as far as is yet made appear unto us; But Duplicates and Confirmation of the Commissioners Power and Actions were sent from the Parliament since the Reduction of *Virginia* and *Maryland*.
