



Order for settling the
 G O V E R N M E N T

VV Hereas by several Orders drawn up and Published at *St. Marie's* the 29. of *March*, and the 28. of *June*, 1652. *Maryland* was Reduced and settled under the Authority and Obedience of the Common-wealth of *England*, as to the Government thereof, by special Order and Command of the Council of State by Commission from the Parliament, and was left in the hands of Captain *William Stone*, Mr. *Hatton*, and others; who were required, and promised to issue out Writs and other Proceſs in the Name of the Keepers of the Liberty of *England*, according to the expreſs words of the Commission and Instructions for Reducing, Settling, and Governing of all the Plantations in the Bay of *Chesapiak* to the Obedience of the Common-wealth of *England*, as in, and by the aforesaid Orders and Proclamations may, and doth appear: And whereas the aforesaid Captain *Stone*, by special Order and Directions from the Lord *Baltimore* as it appeareth, was perswaded, and induced
