Am sorry at present for to let your Honour understand of our sad condition, in your Province. So it is, that my Husband, with the rest of your Councell, went about a month agone with a party of men up to Anne-Arundell County, to bring those sa-

Ations people to obedience under your Government. My Husband sent Dr. Barber with one Mr. Counsey with a Message to them, but they never returned agains before the fight began. Also he sent one Mr. Packer the day after, with a Message, and he likewise never returned, as I heard: but so it is, that upon Sunday the 25. of March, they did ingage with the people of Anne-Arundell, and lost the field, and not above sive of our men escaped; which I did conceive ranne away before the sight was ended; the rest all taken, some killed and wounded; my Husband hath received a wound in his shoulder, but I heare it is upon the men-
