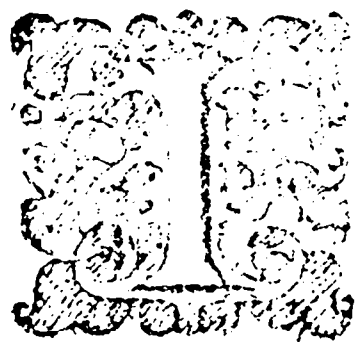


For the Right Honourable the Lord

Am sorry at present for to let your Honour understand of our sad condition, in your Province. So it is, that my Husband, with the rest of your Councell, went about a month agone with a party of men up to *Anne-Arundell* County, to bring those factious people to obedience under your Government. My Husband sent *Dr. Barber* with one *Mr. Cornsey* with a Message to them, but they never returned againe before the fight began. Also he sent one *Mr. Packer* the day after, with a Message, and he likewise never returned, as I heard: but so it is, that upon Sunday the 25. of March, they did ingage with the people of *Anne-Arundell*, and lost the field, and not above five of our men escaped; which I did conceive ranne away before the fight was ended; the rest all taken, some killed and wounded; my Husband hath received a wound in his shoulder, but I heare it is upon the
