

*St. Michaels , Wy River , Chester , Sacifrax River.*

On the *West* side these are the principle Rivers, *Elizabeth, Nansenum, James, Back, Yorke, Rapahanock, Petomock, Patuxon, Soueth, Severn, Gunpowder River, Patapsco;* from which River the *Bay* draws straiter, and devides it self into many lesser Rivers.

Out of which *Bay* and Rivers, there are branched many Navigable Rivers and Creeks, the which no Ten men in the Land are able to nominate.

The Shore on the *East* from the *Bay* to the Ocean, is but about twenty miles broad.

The Rivers on the *West* of the *Bay* are Navigable, some 40. some 50 some 100. some 200. some 300 miles; which *Bay, Rivers* and Creeks are plentiful of Fowle from *September* till *March*, of all sorts, as *Swans, Geese, Brants, Ducks, Widgeon, Teale,* with many other sorts too tedious to relate, some of which tarry with them all *Summer*: And Fish multitudes, as *Porpoesses, Grandpales, Herring-Hoggs, Drums, Sheepsheads, Bass, Mulletts, Pearch, Sturgeon, Eales, Salmon, Trouts, Thornbacks, Garrs, Cats, Oysters, Crabs, Turtles,* with many more too tedious to relate.
